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
Course design

Since the discipline of project management is aimed at a specific type of student - the working adult - it is necessary to take into account the limited and fragmented availability of time that this category of students has. A research study was carried out in recent years to evaluate how distance learning is carried out for adults, both in Italy and abroad (Cambridge University). We investigated all the relative issues and worked to structure the suitable solution for this type of student.

A4PM® has activated a **modern blended e-learning platform** where you can take advantage of various courses in Project Management, each of which is **conceived almost completely in asynchronous mode** (this way it is possible to study in any time that is convenient for the working student in self-learning mode) **and partly in synchrony**, that is with the integration of appointments with the teacher to check the understanding of the topics and guide the student to the successful completion of the course.



Duration and access to Courses:
